Why Should You Seal Your Juvenile Record?

Your juvenile record is not automatically sealed when you turn 18. It could hurt your ability to find a job, get a driver's license, or get into college.

If you are a non-citizen, it could make you ineligible for citizenship.

Once your record is sealed, it's as if the proceedings never took place.

You can legally say you were never adjudicated or
arrested for the sealed offenses.
